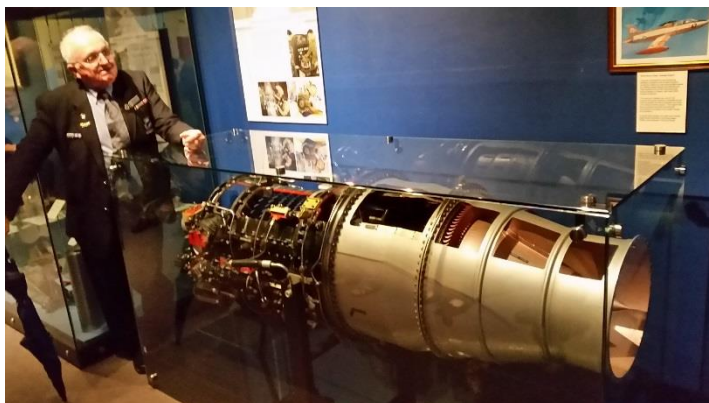

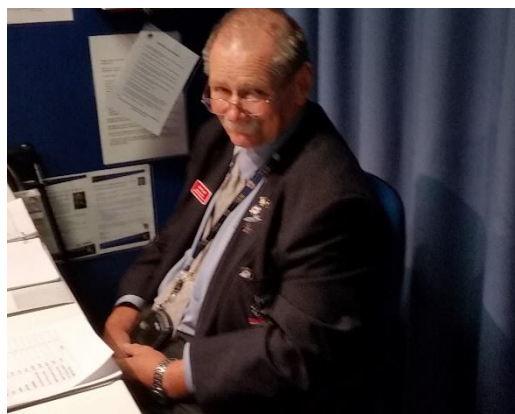




Afterwards, we adjourned to the Koorungal Hotel for dinner – regrettably there are no pics ...
